

# **MOBILE PHONES – STUDENT USE**

# **PURPOSE**

To explain to our school community the Department's and Foster Secondary College's policy requirements and expectations relating to students using mobile phones and other personal mobile devices during school hours.

# **SCOPE**

This policy applies to:

- 1. All students at Foster Secondary College; and
- 2. Students' personal mobile phones and other personal mobile devices brought onto school premises during school hours, including recess and lunchtime.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

**A mobile phone** is a telephone with access to a cellular (telecommunication) system, with or without a physical connection to a network. Other personal mobile devices include cellular compatible watches.

# POLICY

Foster Secondary College understands that students may bring a personal mobile phone to school, particularly if they are travelling independently to and from school.

At Foster Secondary College:

- Students who choose to bring mobile phones to school must have them switched off and securely stored during school hours
- Exceptions to this policy may be applied if certain conditions are met (see below for further information)
- When emergencies occur, parents or carers should reach their child by calling the school's office.

#### Personal mobile phone use

In accordance with the Department's <u>Mobile Phones — Student Use Policy</u> issued by the Minister for Education, personal mobile phones must not be used at Foster Secondary College during school hours, including lunchtime and recess, unless an exception has been granted.

Where a student has been granted an exception, the student must use their mobile phone for the purpose for which the exception was granted, and in a safe, ethical and responsible manner.

# Secure storage

Mobile phones owned by students at Foster Secondary College are considered valuable items and are brought to school at the owner's (student's or parent/carer's) risk. Students are encouraged not to bring a mobile phone to school unless there is a compelling reason to do so. Please note that Foster Secondary College does not have accident insurance for accidental property damage or theft. Students and their parents/carers are encouraged to obtain appropriate insurance for valuable items. Refer to the Department's Claims for Property Damage and Medical Expenses policy.

Where students bring a mobile phone to school, Foster Secondary College will provide secure storage. Secure storage is storage that cannot be readily accessed by those without permission to do so. At Foster Secondary College students are required to store their phones in their lockers at the start of the school day, which is then securely locked and not removed from the locker until after the final bell for the day.

# Enforcement

Students who use their personal mobile phones inappropriately at Foster Secondary College may be issued with consequences consistent with our school's existing student policies.

At Foster Secondary College inappropriate use of mobile phones is **any use during school hours**, unless an exception has been granted. Students found with their mobile phone will be asked to take their phone to the general office where it will be safely stored until the end of the school day when it may be collected by the student. If a student is found to have contravened the policy a second time, the phone will be securely stored in the office and a parent or guardian will be contacted to come to the school to collect the phone.

The use of a mobile phone in the following circumstances will constitute a more serious breach of the policy and student code of conduct:

- sending inappropriate, harassing or threatening messages or phone calls
- engaging in inappropriate social media use including cyber bullying
- to capture video or images of people, including students, teachers and members of the school community without their permission
- to capture video or images in the school toilets, changing rooms, swimming pools and gyms
- during exams and assessments

At Foster Secondary College inappropriate use of mobile phones is any use during school hours, unless an exception has been granted, and particularly use of a mobile phone:

- in any way that disrupts the learning of others
- to send inappropriate, harassing or threatening messages or phone calls
- to engage in inappropriate social media use including cyber bullying
- to capture video or images of people, including students, teachers and members of the school community without their permission

- to capture video or images in the school toilets, changing rooms, swimming pools and gyms
- during exams and assessments

# Exceptions

Exceptions to the policy:

- may be applied during school hours if certain conditions are met, specifically,
  - Health and wellbeing-related exceptions; and
  - Exceptions related to managing risk when students are offsite.
- can be granted by the Principal, or by the teacher for that class, in accordance with the Department's <u>Mobile Phones Student Use Policy</u>.

The three categories of exceptions allowed under the Department's <u>Mobile Phones — Student Use</u> <u>Policy</u> are:

#### 1. Learning-related exceptions

Specific exception	Documentation
For specific learning activities (class-based exception)	Example recording performance in gymnastics.
For students for whom a reasonable adjustment to a learning program is needed because of a disability or learning difficulty	Individual Education Plan as developed by coordinators and school support staff.

# 2. Health and wellbeing-related exceptions

Specific exception	Documentation
Students with a health condition	Student Health Support Plan
Students who are Young Carers	A localised student record

# 3. Exceptions related to managing risk when students are offsite

Specific exception	Documentation
Travelling to and from excursions	Risk assessment planning documentation
Students on excursions and camps	Risk assessment planning documentation
When students are offsite (not on school grounds) and unsupervised with parental permission	Risk assessment planning documentation
Students with a dual enrolment or who need to undertake intercampus travel	Risk assessment planning documentation

Where an exception is granted, the student can only use the mobile phone for the purpose for which it was granted.

# Camps, excursions and extracurricular activities

Foster Secondary College will provide students and their parents and carers with information about items that can or cannot be brought to camps, excursions, special activities and events, including personal mobile phones.

# Exclusions

This policy does not apply to

- Out-of-School-Hours Care (OSHC)
- Out-of-school-hours events
- Travelling to and from school
- Wearable devices
- iPads and all other personal devices
- Students undertaking workplace learning activities, e.g. work experience
- Students who are undertaking VET
